The Goethe University Frankfurt am Main, together with the Fritz Bauer Institute, Study- and Documentation Center on the History and Impact of the Holocaust, invites applications for the post of

Visiting Professor or Visiting Researcher

for one semester (4 to 6 months),

in the winter semester 2016/17.

The post is situated at the Fritz Bauer Institute. This post supports the main focus of the Institute, namely research into the Holocaust and its impact to this day. A researcher or professor of Holocaust studies is sought who works on an interdisciplinary basis and whose main focus is located in research into the history and impact of the Holocaust in Germany or Europe-wide from the perspective of the social sciences, the humanities or the human sciences.

The Fritz Bauer Institute will place its infrastructure at the disposal of the successful candidate for his/her research activity. If possible, the successful candidate should offer two teaching courses per week, namely one lecture and one seminar in the case of a guest professor or two tutorials in the case of a guest researcher. In addition, the successful candidate should advise the Fritz Bauer Institute regarding its own research activities.

Applications from abroad are welcome. A prerequisite for applicants from Germany is a doctoral degree for guest researchers and a post-doctoral qualification (Habilitation) for guest professors.

The salary is calculated in accordance with the guidelines of the Executive Committee for the Employment of Substitute and Guest Professors and Guest Researchers.
